



Frequently Asked Questions

***Note – the following information pertains ONLY to players who have qualified to play in the 2015 APA 8-Ball Classic or APA 9-Ball Shootout in Las Vegas, Nevada.**

IMPORTANT!

If you are a qualified player for the 2015 National Singles Championships in 8-Ball or 9-Ball, please **DO NOT** contact the Riviera Hotel & Casino directly to make rooming reservations. When you qualified to participate in the National Singles Championships, you filled out a **Registration and Room Reservation Form**; this form was sent to the APA National Office and a room has been secured for you.

➤ **When are the 2015 APA National Singles Championships?**

The 9-Ball Shootout is April 29-May 1.

The 8-Ball Classic is May 1-3.

➤ **When is player registration for the National Singles Championships?**

The **9-Ball Shootout** player registration is **Wednesday, April 29** from 6PM – 10PM. The mandatory player's meeting will be from 8:00AM-8:30AM on Thursday, April 30. Tournament action will begin at 9:00AM.

The **8-Ball Classic** player registration is **Friday, May 1** from Noon-5:00PM, followed by a mandatory player's meeting at 6:30PM. Tournament action will begin at 7:00PM.

➤ **How many rooming nights do I receive for qualifying?**

Qualified players receive three (3) nights single occupancy rooming at the Riviera as part of your qualification package. The dates of occupancy are:

- April 29 (check in) – May 2 (check out) for the 9-Ball Shootout
- May 1 (check in) – May 4 (check out) for the 8-Ball Classic

Players who are qualified for BOTH the 8-Ball Classic and the 9-Ball Shootout will receive five nights rooming. The dates of occupancy are April 29 (check in) – May 4 (check out).

➤ **What if I want to room with another qualified player?**

You may room with another qualified player, but please note that your rooming will only be covered for the three nights of your event. Please call our National Singles Championships hotline at 636-625-8611 ext. 5560 and leave us a message. An APA representative will return your call. Or you can email your requests to specialevents@poolplayers.com. We will be happy to discuss your specific situation and options with you.



➤ **What if I want to bring a friend or significant other with me? Will I have to pay extra for my room?**

You are welcome to bring a guest(s) along with you to stay in your room at no extra cost. The maximum occupancy for each room is four people.

➤ **What are the hotel check-in and check-out times?**

Hotel check-in begins at 4:00 PM and check-out is 11:00 AM.

➤ **What do I do if I want to add additional nights to my rooming and how much will it cost?**

Please call our National Singles Championship hotline at 636-625-8611 ext. 5560 and leave us a message that you would like to add additional nights rooming to your reservation. An APA representative will return your call and set this up for you. You may also request additional rooming nights by emailing us at specialevents@poolplayers.com.

You will be charged \$69 per night plus tax for any additional nights lodging. Payment will be collected by the Riviera Hotel and Casino at the Guest Registration counter.

➤ **Does the APA National Office make my travel arrangements?**

APA does not make travel arrangements for you. You will need to contact a travel agent or the airlines direct. We do, however, provide travel assistance money to help offset the cost of transportation. You will receive your travel assistance money at Player Registration. Don't wait to make your travel arrangements – start early and shop around for the best travel deals!

➤ **How much travel assistance money will I receive and when will I receive the money?**

All travel assistance money will be paid out onsite in cash at tournament registration. The amount of travel assistance money you will receive depends on how many miles away your League Area is from Las Vegas, and you should have been notified of the amount you will receive when you won your qualifier. If you have questions regarding the amount you will receive, please contact your local League Operator.

➤ **Do you post the match schedules in advance of the tournament?**

Match schedules will not be released or posted in advance – you must wait until you are onsite to find out your first scheduled match time.
